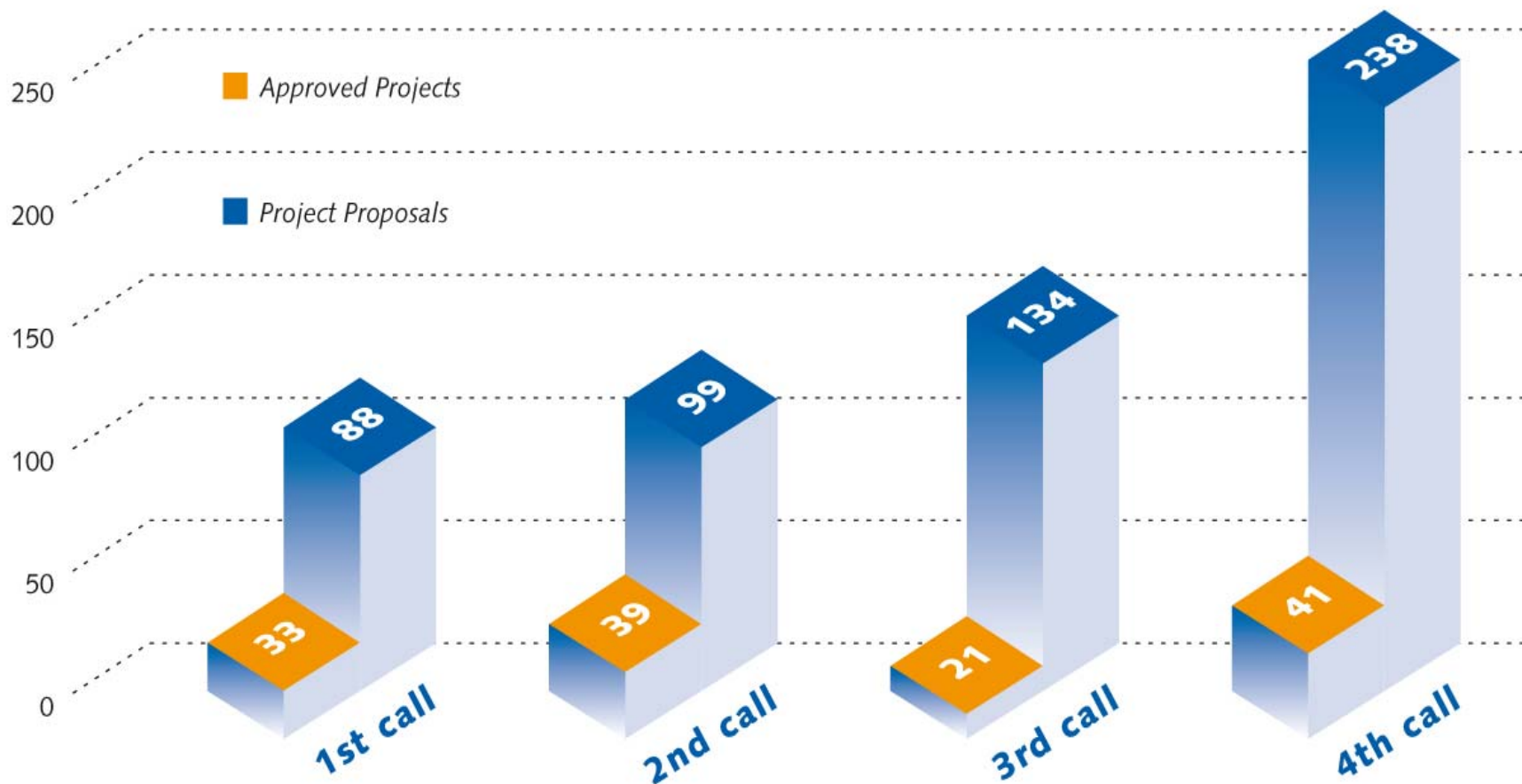

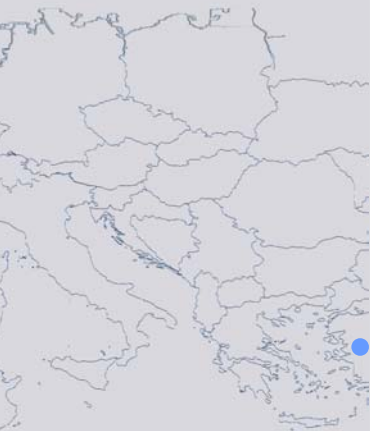
- 18 countries involved
- ERDF-funds committed – 153 million EURO
- Total amount committed to the projects 260 million EURO

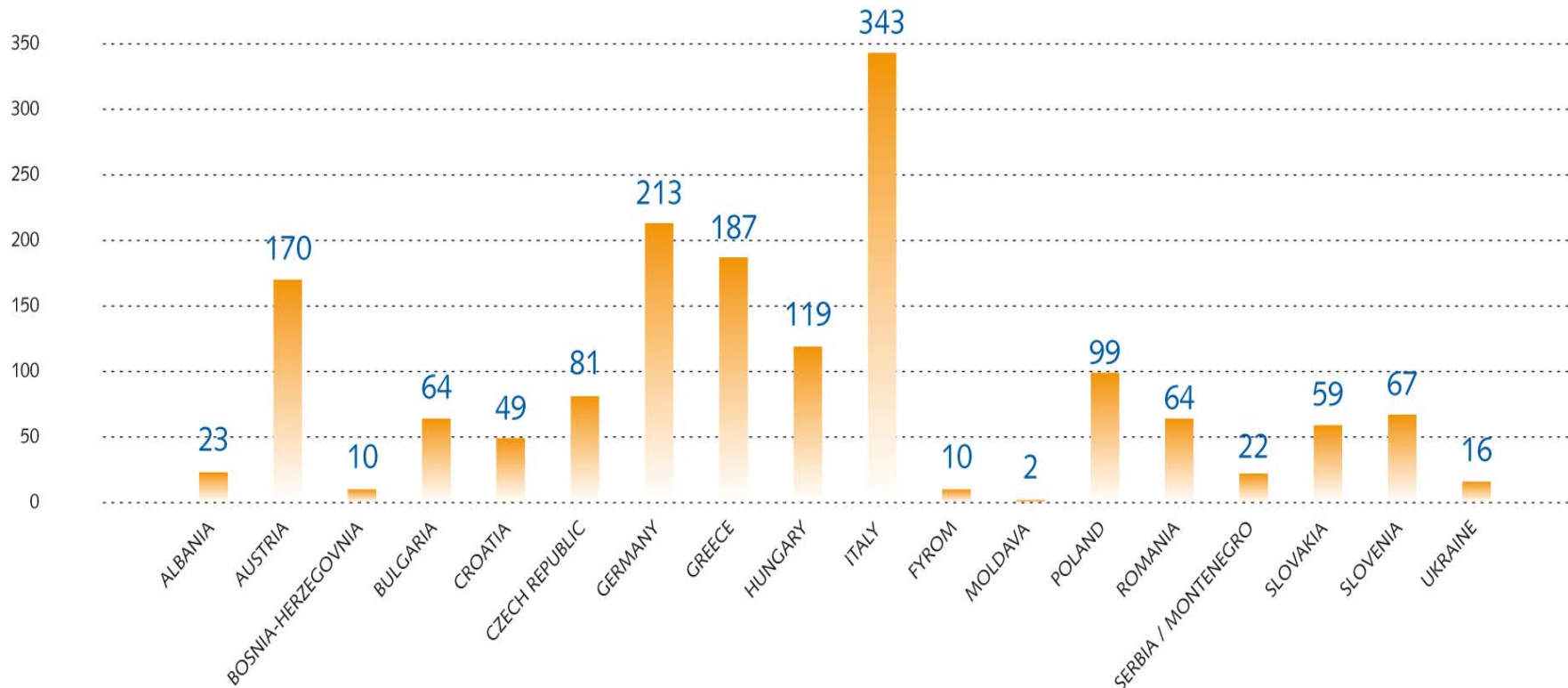
1. Framework and dimension of CADSES

- Involvement of the non EU-Member States under the framework of Neighbourhood Policy of the EU (coordination of ERDF, PHARE, CARDS, TACIS)
- Transsectoral partnerships - no restriction concerning the legal status of the PPs
- 534 private institutions involved in the project implementation; share in the total budget committed 31%

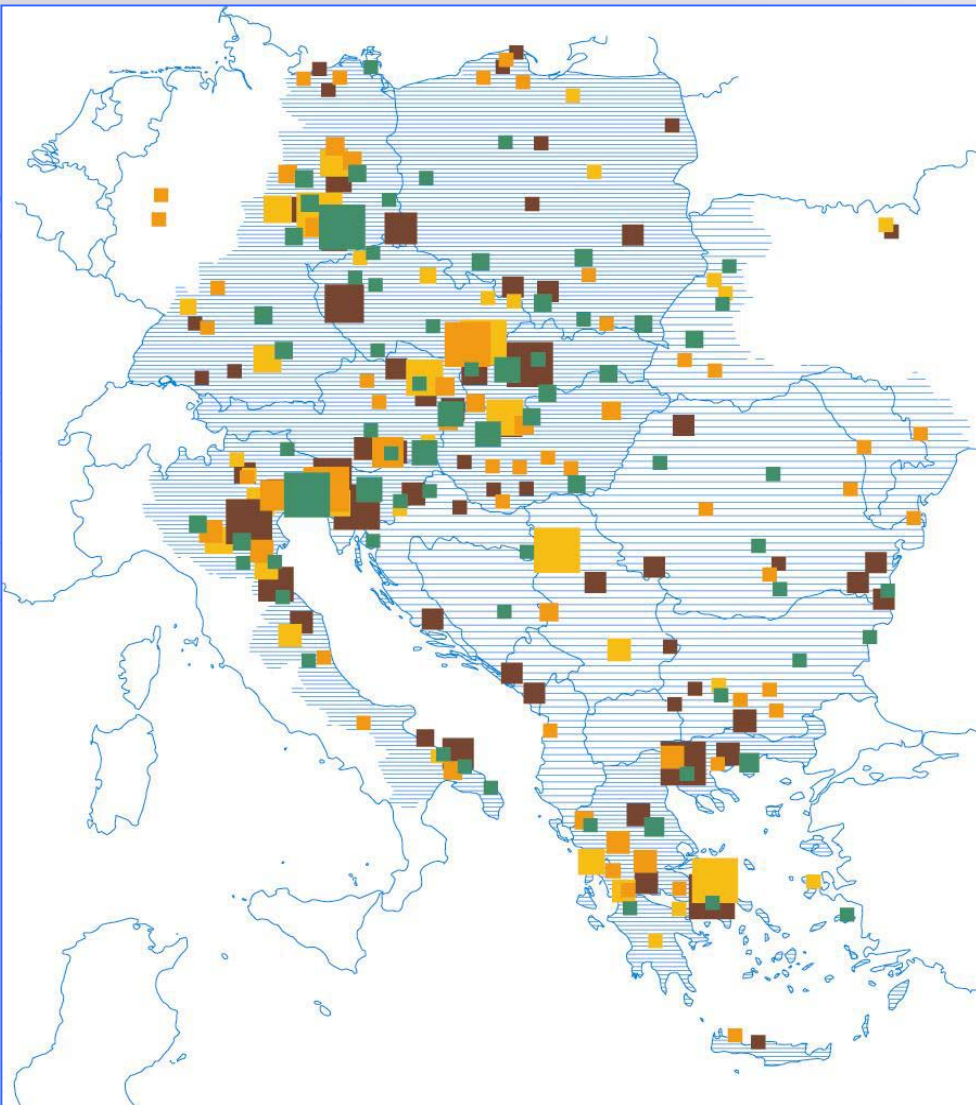

- Nearly 1614 institutions involved in the implementation of the projects



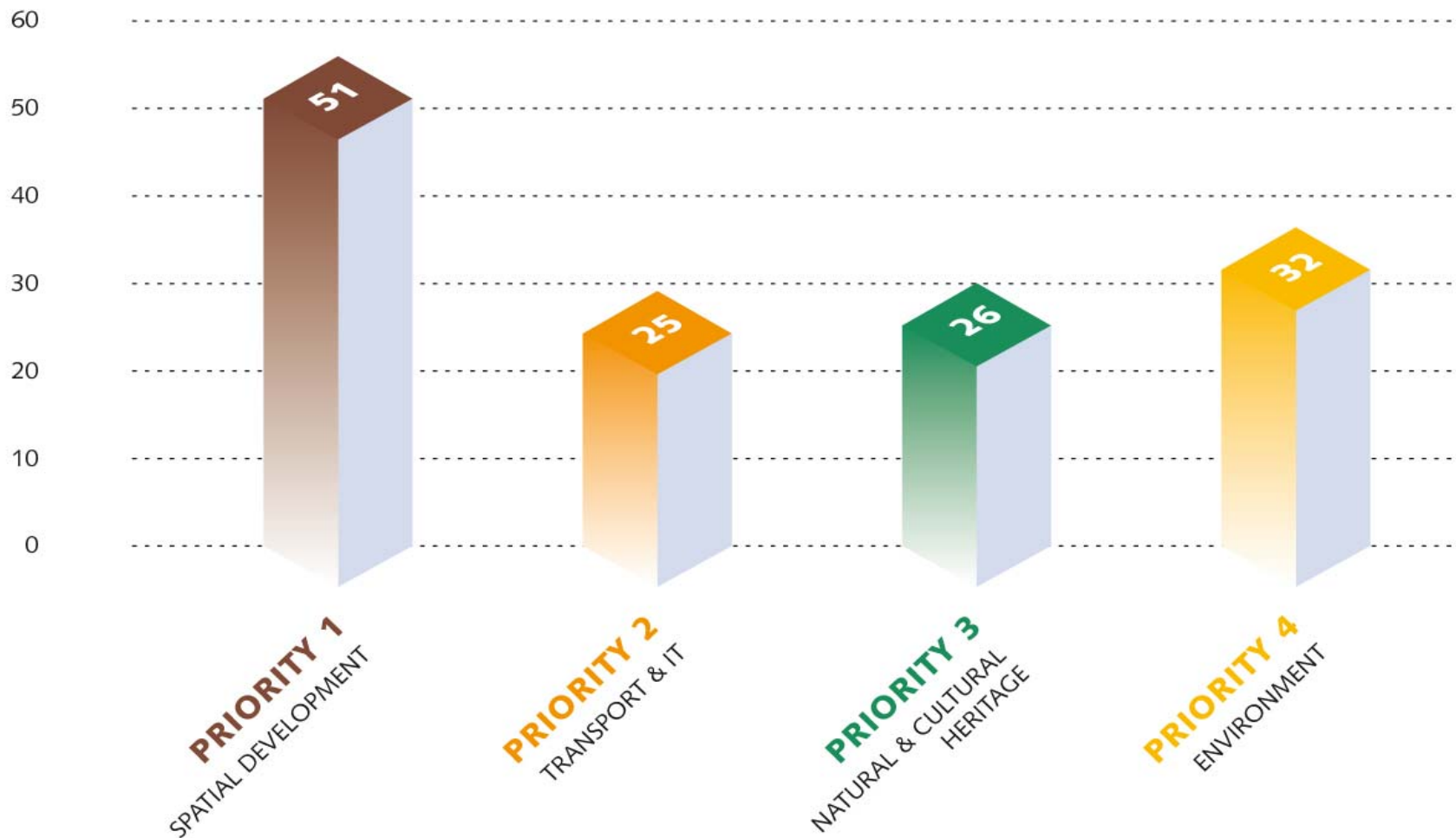

- Successful implementation of the EU neighbourhood policy under CADSES

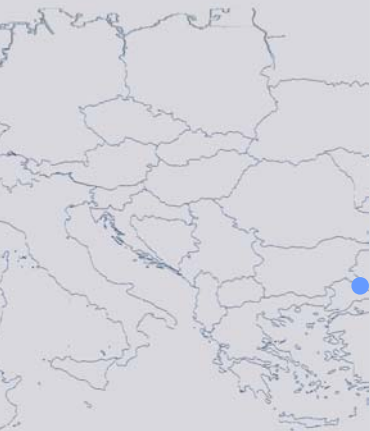

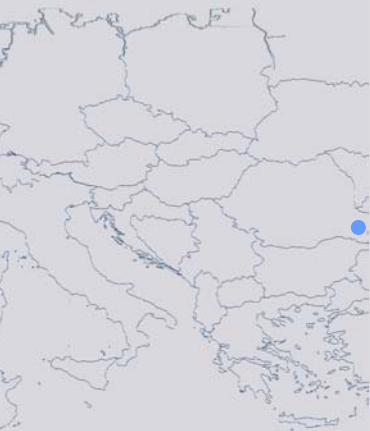
2. CADSES Projects

- Transnational character of the project (partnership and activities - exchange of information, joint studies/analysis)
- Transnational, regional, local networking

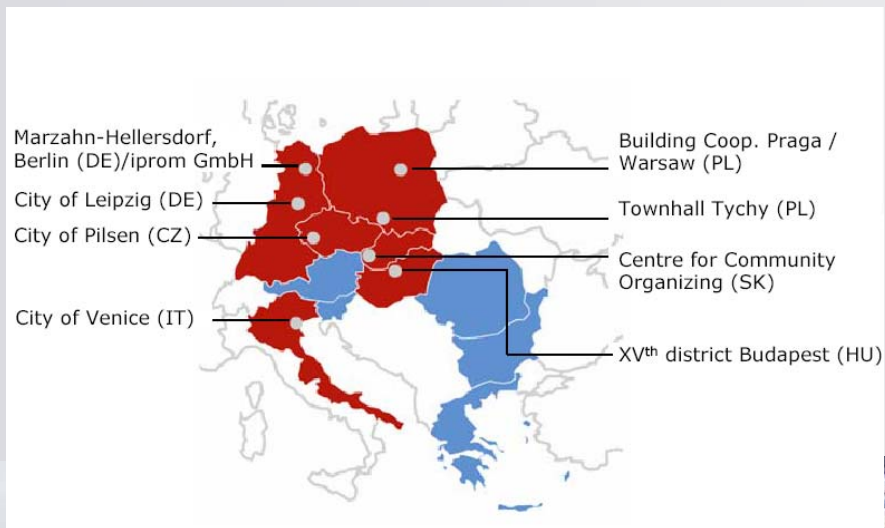


2. CADSES Project examples Carpathian Project

- Collection and systematisation of the information on the Carpathian region, analysis of the key socio-economic sectors
- Elaboration of the integrated strategies for the development of the Carpathians
- Identification of strategic priorities for investment and follow-up measures

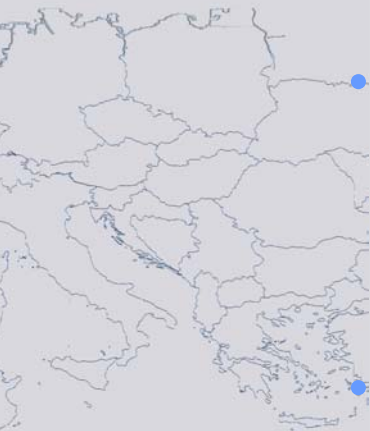

2. CADSES Project examples - LHASA

- Large Housing Areas Stabilisation Action
- Coordinated measures addressing the urban development, revitalisation, stimulating local economic activities and social inclusion
- Transfer of experience and planning expertise from Germany and Italy to the institutions from new EU-Member States for the sake of preparation of the investments



2. CADSES Project examples - IMONODE

- Development of sustainable and efficient intermodal freight transport system in South-Eastern Europe
- Assessment of intermodal transport demand at regional level, infrastructure and services, identification of transport bottlenecks
- Enhancement of accessibility of transport corridors V and X with priority on rail transport



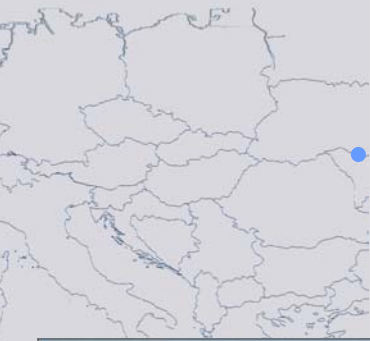
2. CADSES Project examples - Romit

- Roman Itineraries – establishment of the cultural route of the Roman archeological sites
- Use of the cultural potential for the promotion of the generic tourism



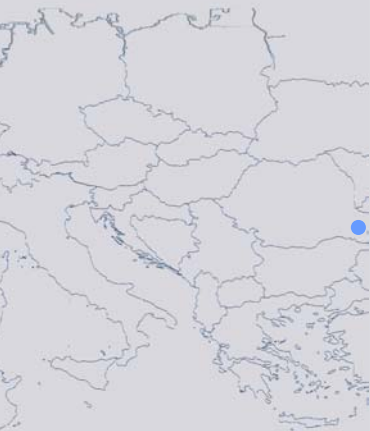
2. CADSES Project examples - Revitamin

- REVITAMIN – revitalisation of former brown coal mining areas
- Development of a transnational computer-aided multicriteria decision aid for mining regions



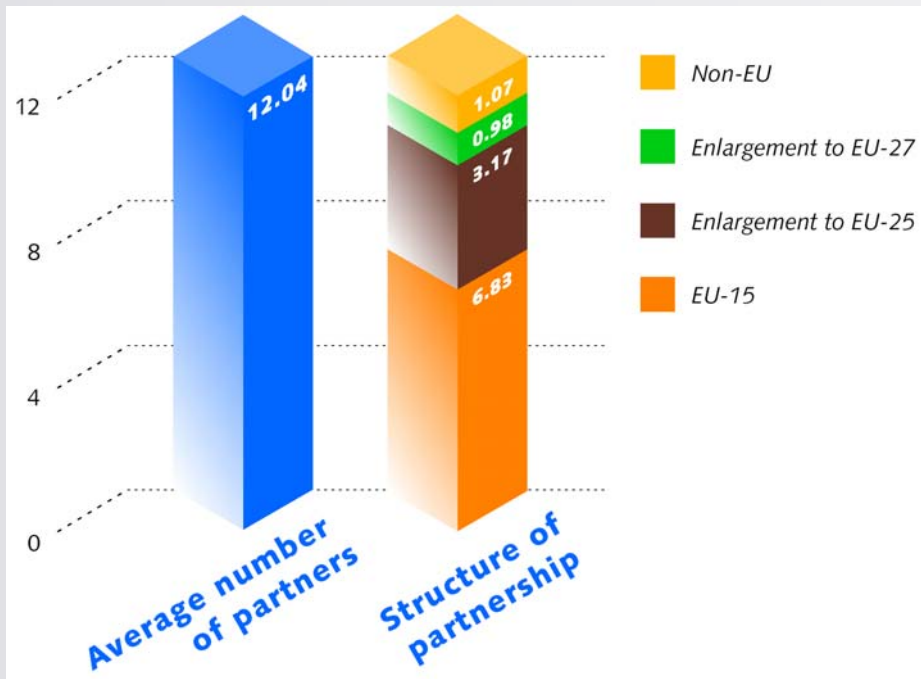
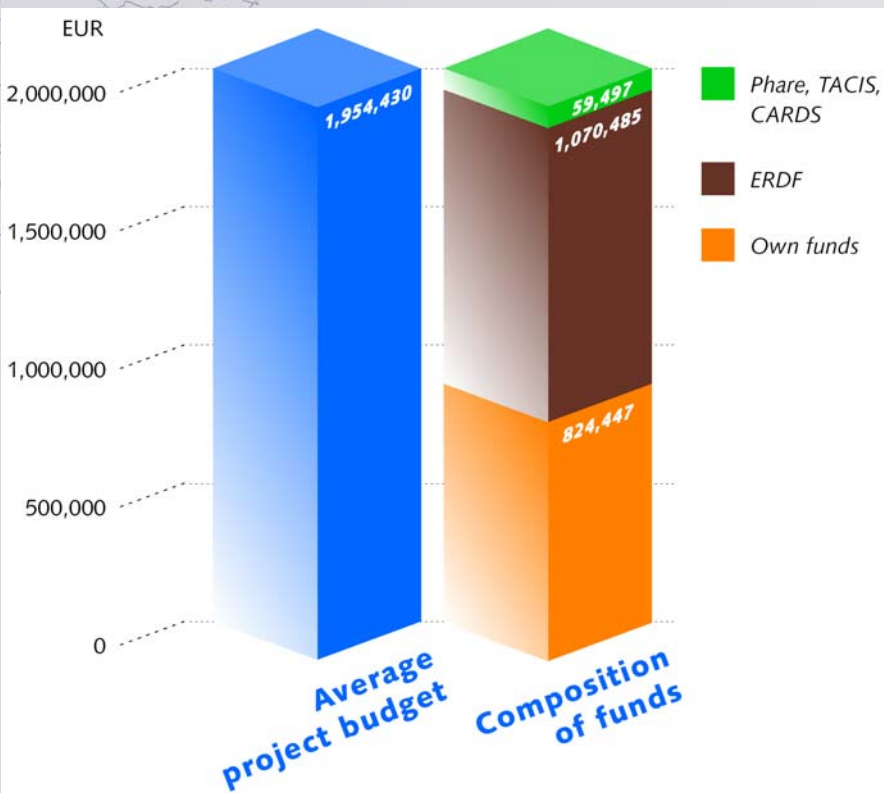
2. CADSES Project examples - ODERREGIO

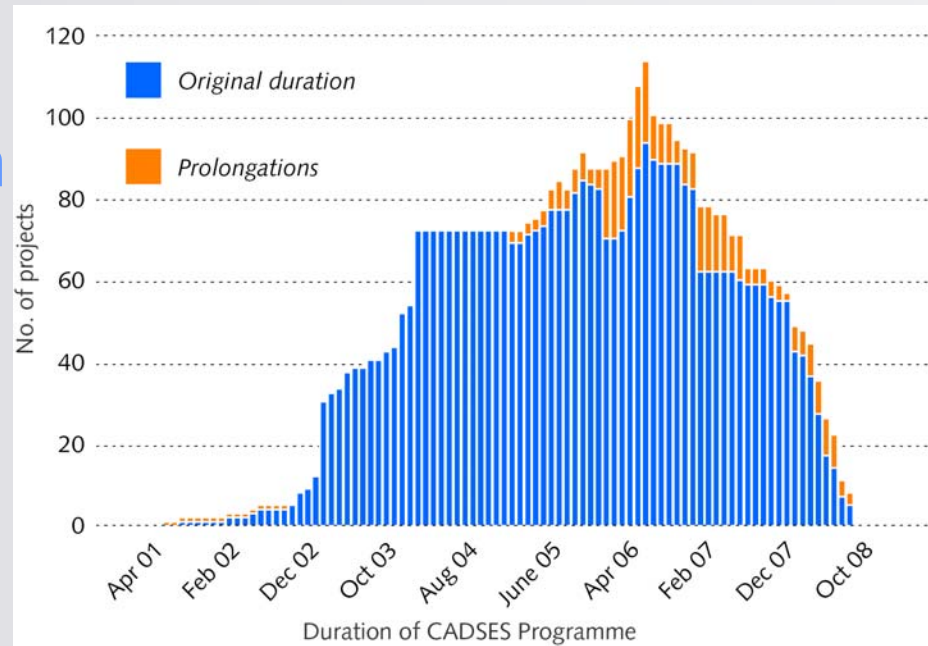
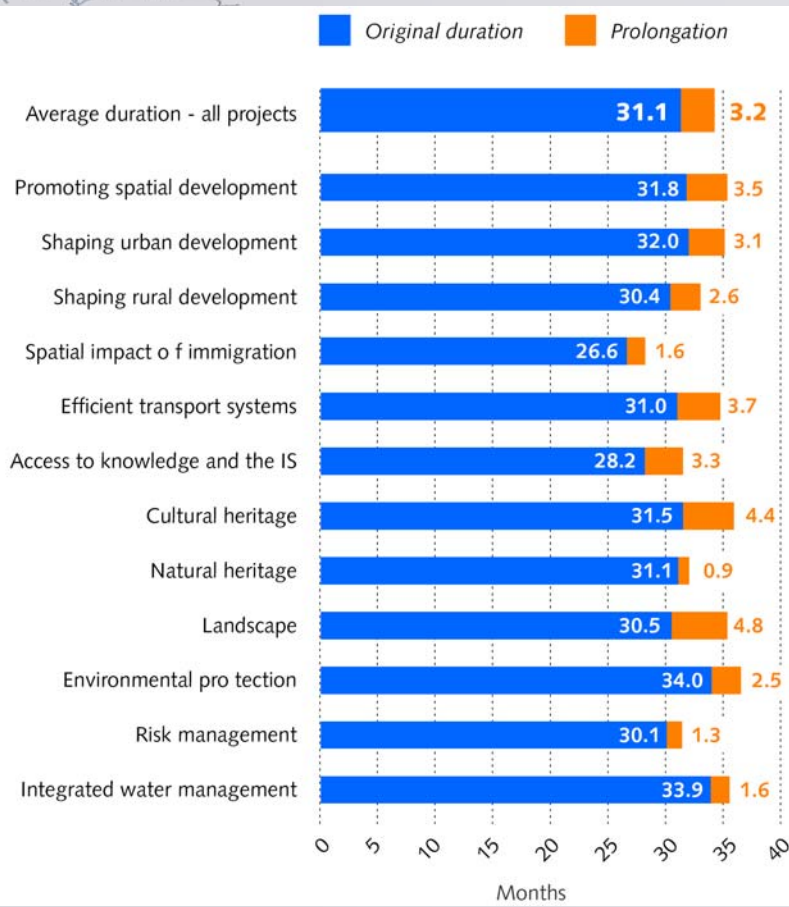
- Structure of the project partnership under CADSES



Structure of the project budget under CADSES

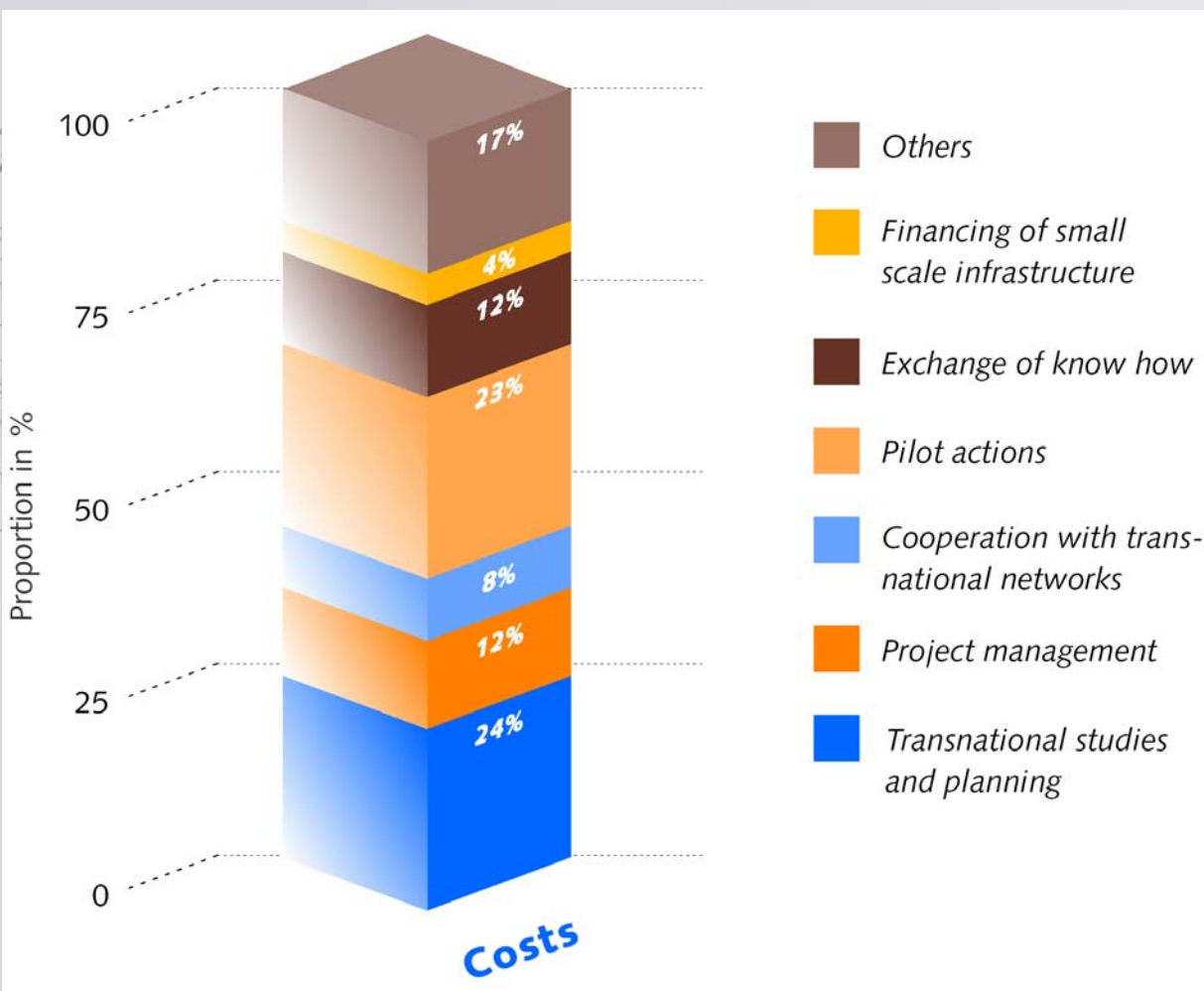

Average project duration 34 months

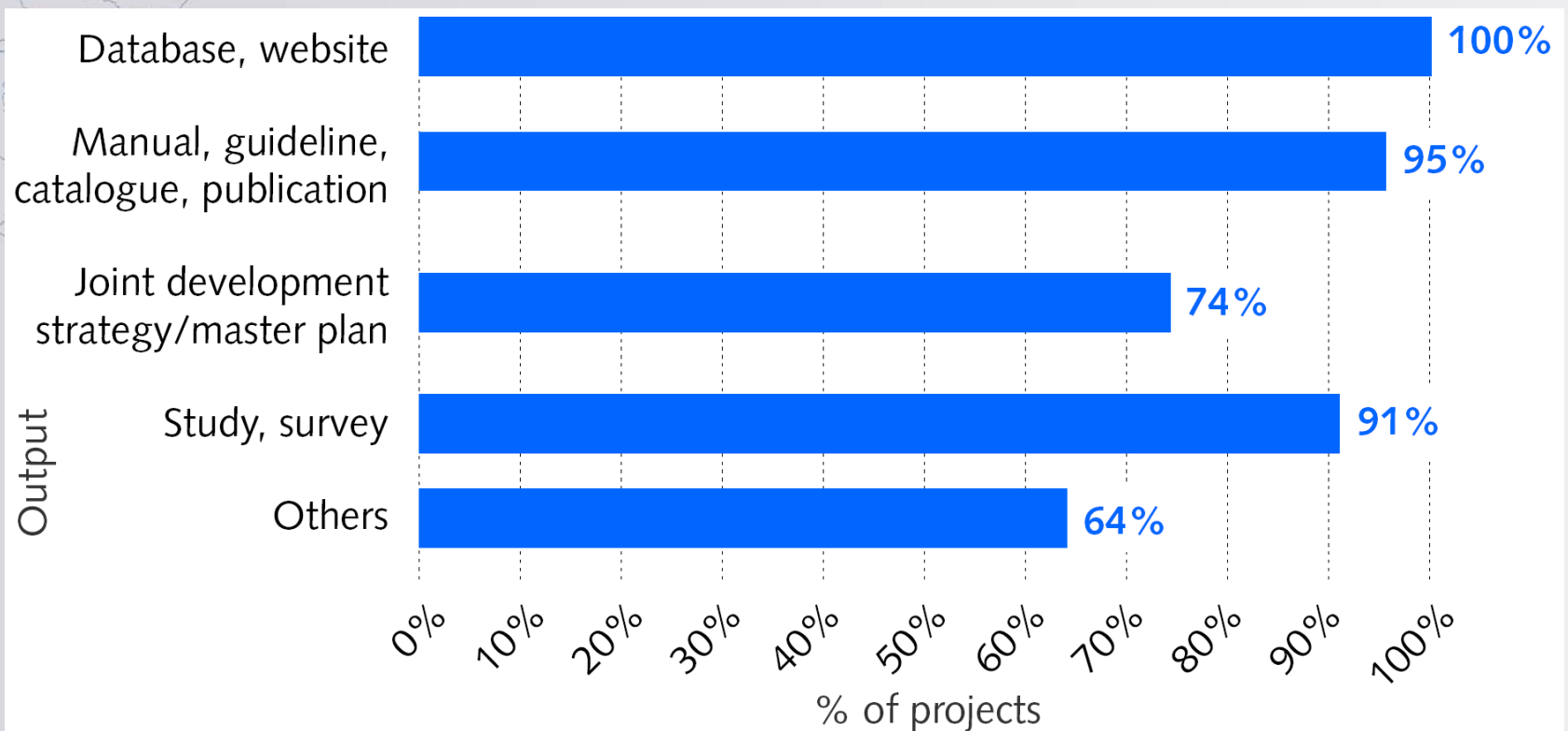
2. CADSES Projects



- Activities - clear focus on orientation on the testing/implementation
- Roughly 47% of the budget dedicated to the pilot actions and transnational studies and planning

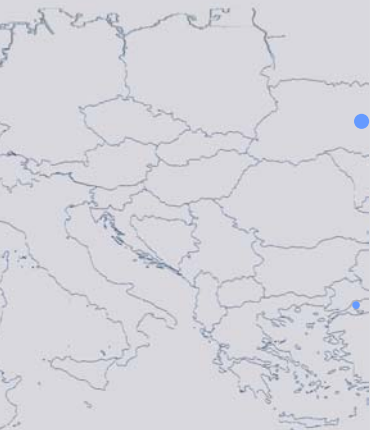
2. CADSES Projects

- Structure of outputs – proof of the joint actions aimed at the exchange of ideas, transfer of know-how collection of data, evaluation, testing, dissemination



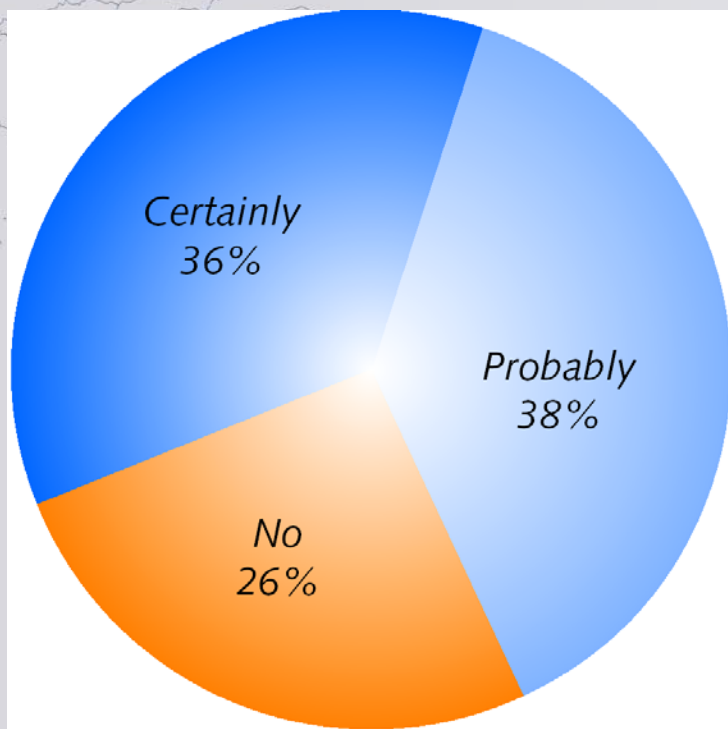
3. CADSES achievements

- Strategic bottom-up approach to the regional/local development

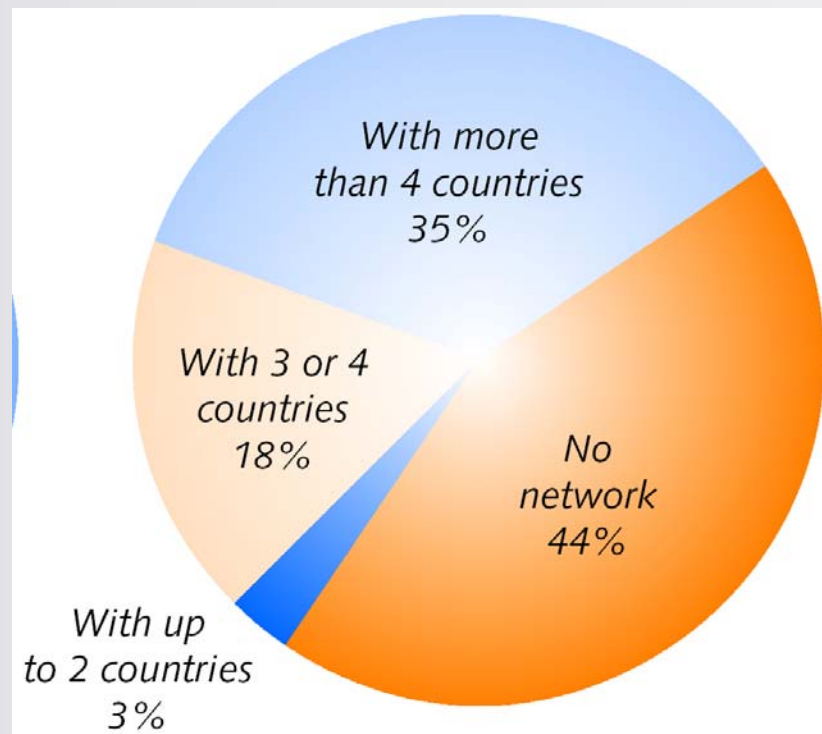


3. CADSES achievements

- Networking! (transnational and regional/transsectoral), transfer of know-how, empowerment,



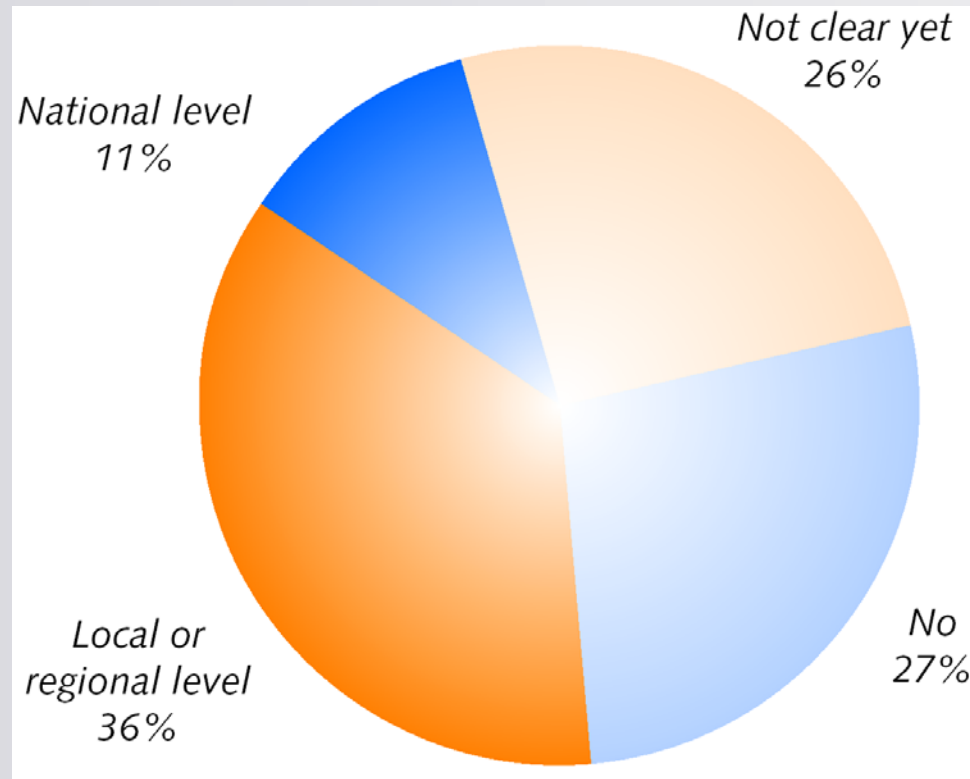
Continuity of the partnership after the project



Transnational networks beyond partnership

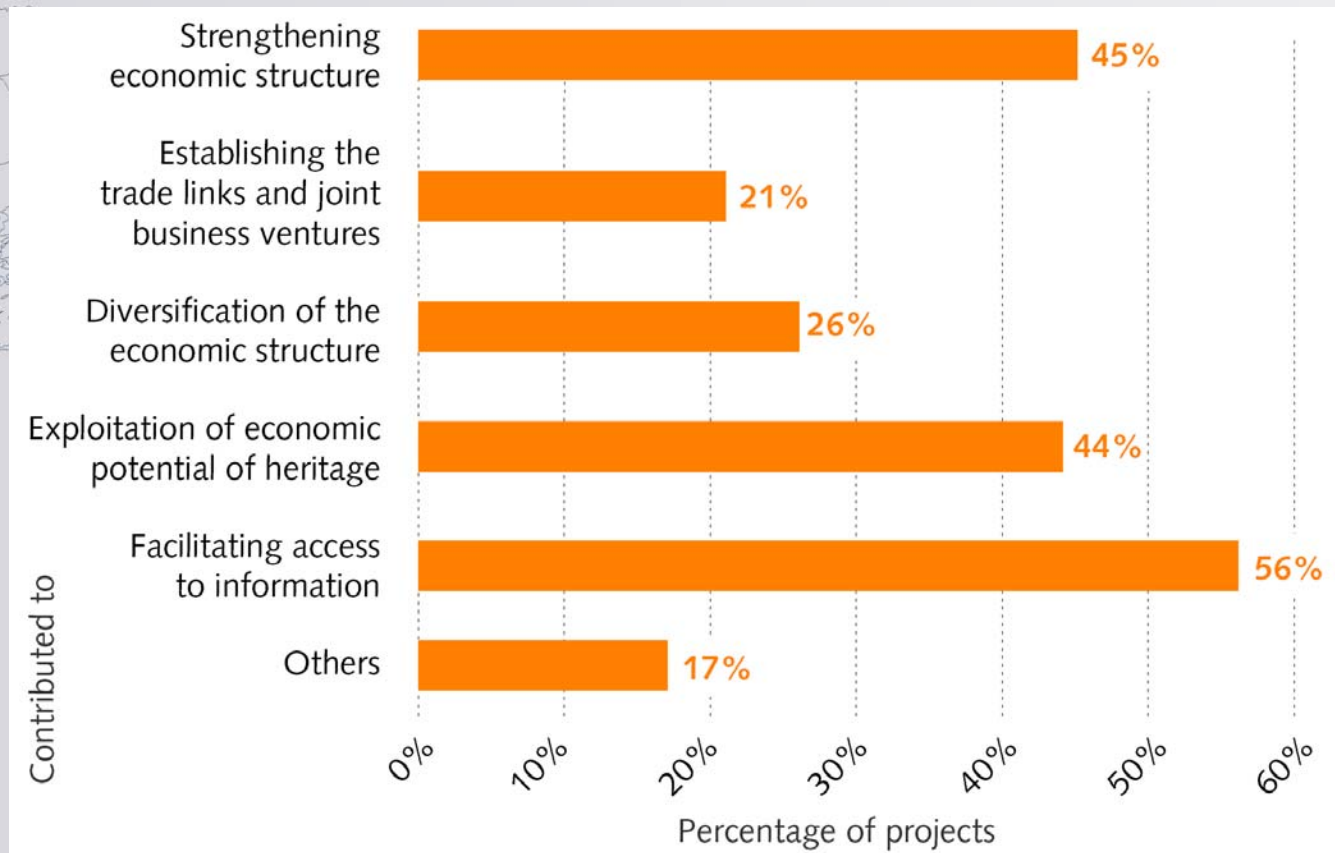
3. CADSES achievements

- Contribution to the shaping the local/regional and national policies - adoption of the project results by the policy-making bodies



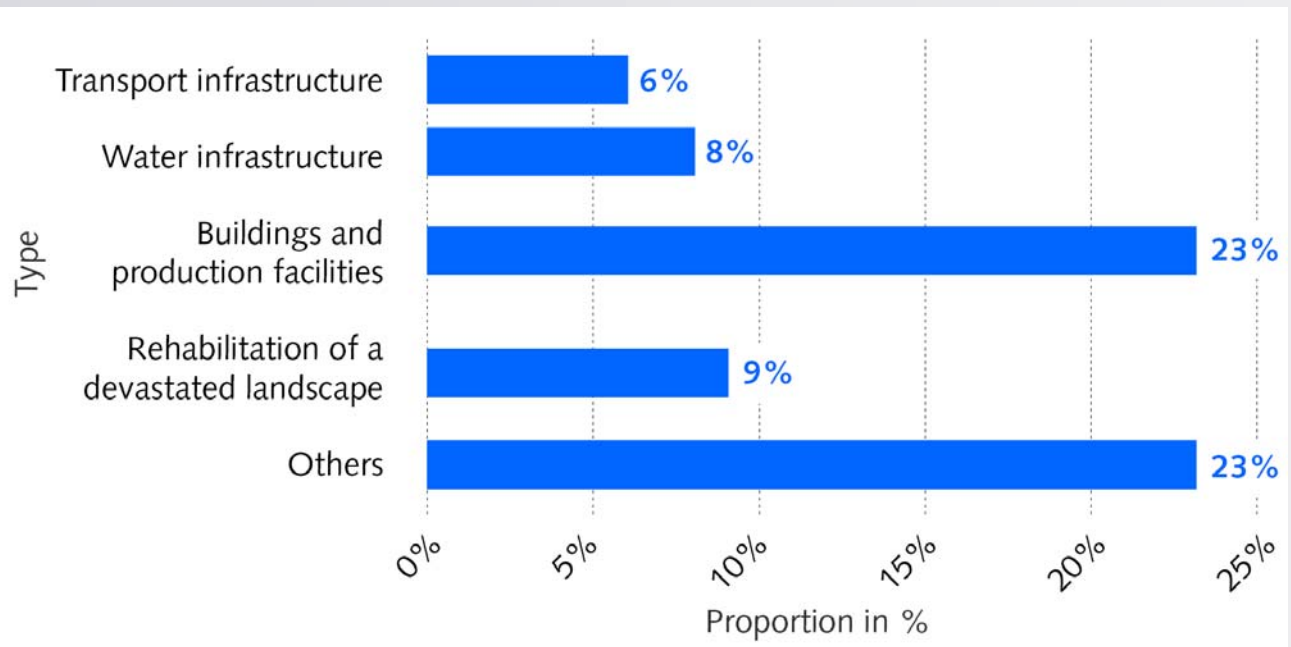
3. CADSES achievements

3. CADSES achievements

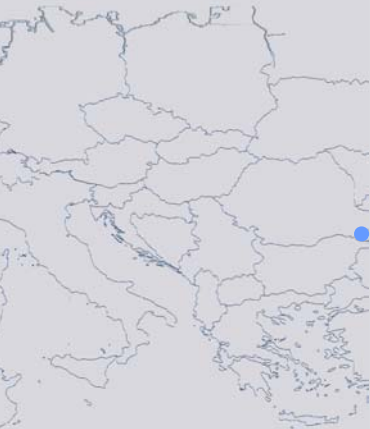


- Instrument of the political integration of the non-EU Member States

- Communication activities/campaigns of the projects aiming at attracting the interest of the decision makers is mainly focused on the project implementation



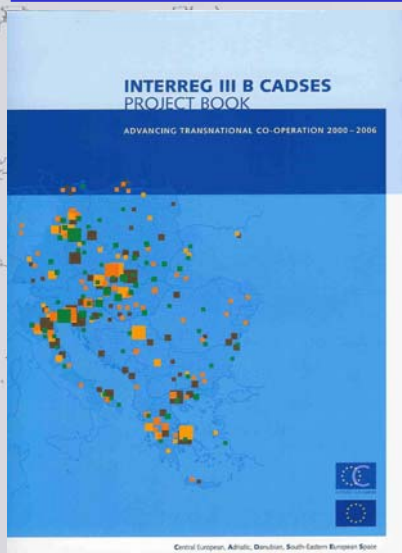
4. Ownership of the project results



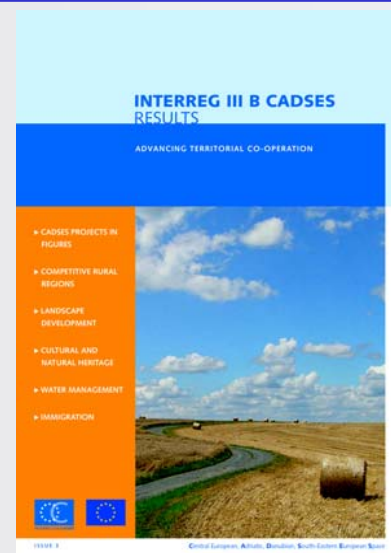
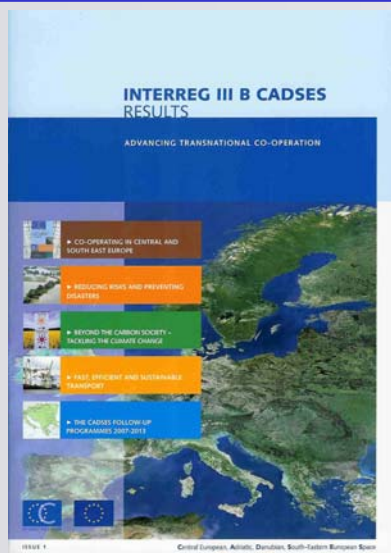
- Limited availability of funds, limited duration of the projects enforces the focus of the project activities on the delivery of outputs foreseen
- Thus supporting concerted actions of the Programme institutions necessary to ensure the long-term oriented knowledge management
