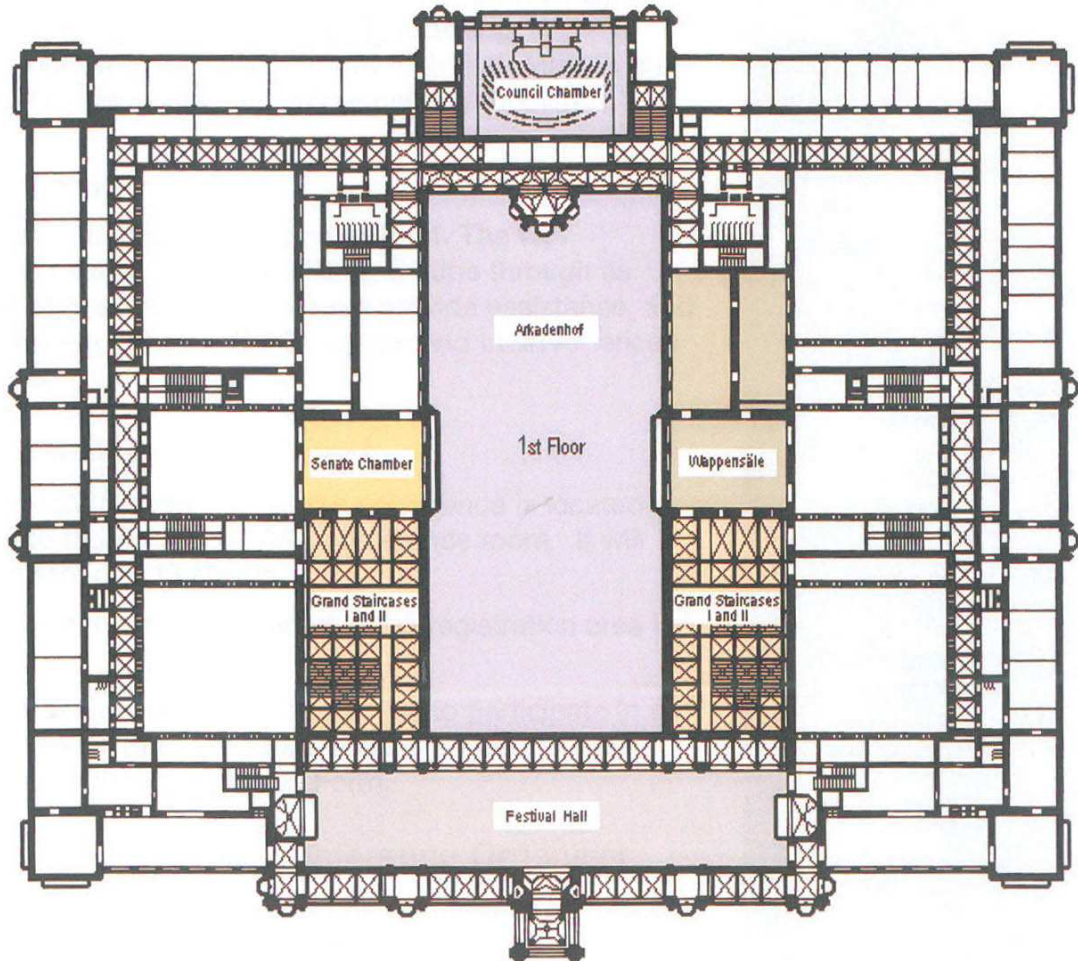

DIRECTIONS TO THE HOTEL

We have reserved rooms at the Josefshof Hotel in Vienna, breakfast included and have negotiated good rates, single room €91 or double room €111 payable when you leave the hotel. From Westbahnhof Station:

Take the underground line U3 (orange line) in the direction of Simmering travel 3 stations and change at "Volkstheater". From here please take U2 (violet line) in the direction of "Schottenring", please travel 1 stop and leave the train at "Rathaus". Please cross the big street and turn left, on your right hand side you will find a small street called "Josefsgasse".

From the airport Wien Schwechat:

Please use the public transport (CAT, airport shuttle or S7) and drive to the city centre Landstraße/Wien Mitte. Here you can use the underground line U3 (orange line) in the direction of "Ottakring", please travel 4 stations to "Volkstheater". Please change to U2 (violet line) and travel 1 stop to "Rathaus". Go out of the station, cross the big street and turn left. On your right hand side you will find a small street called Josefsgasse. There you will find the hotel.
